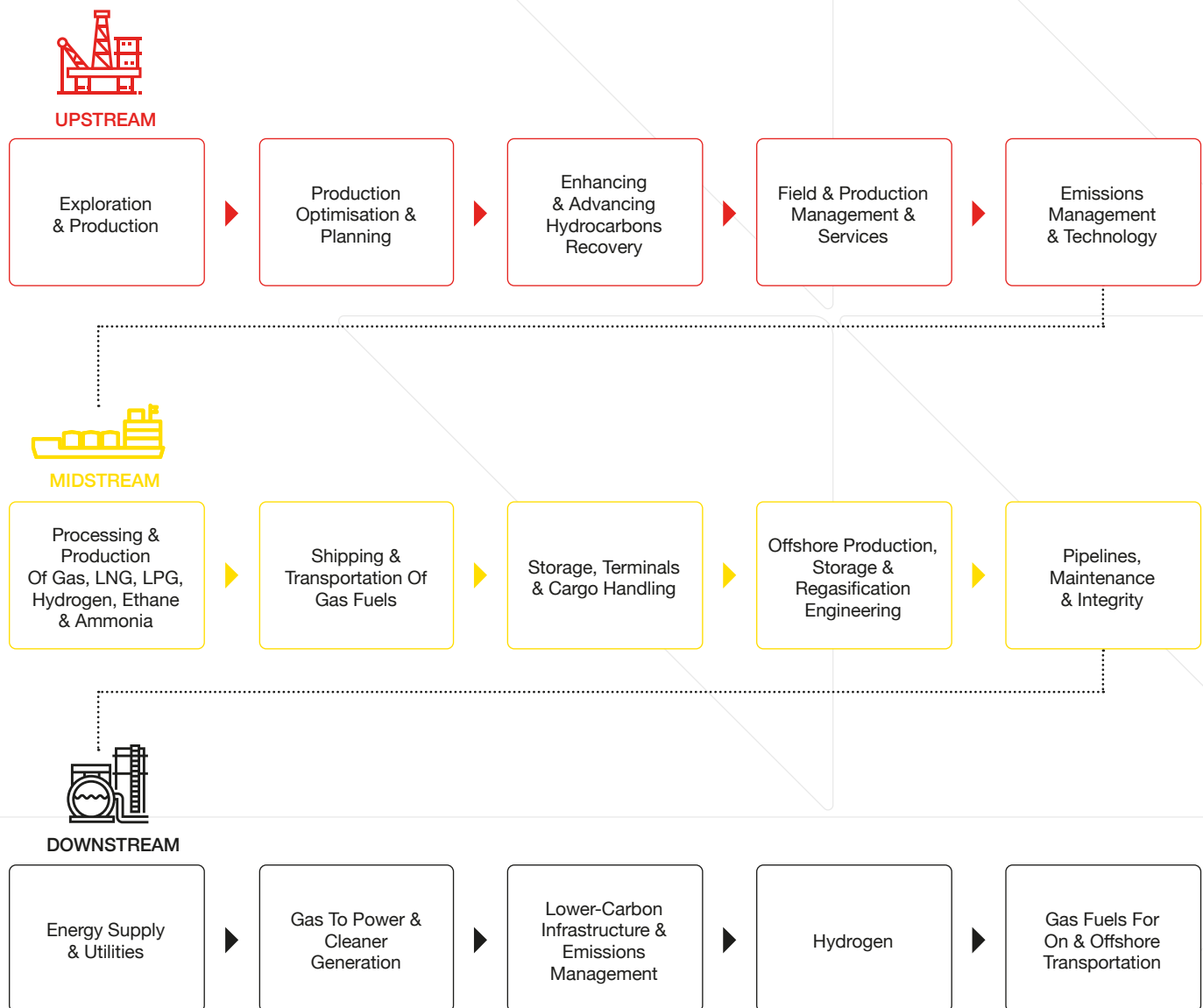

The value chains illustrated below reflect some of the areas of the exhibition and topics that will be addressed during Gastech 2023.



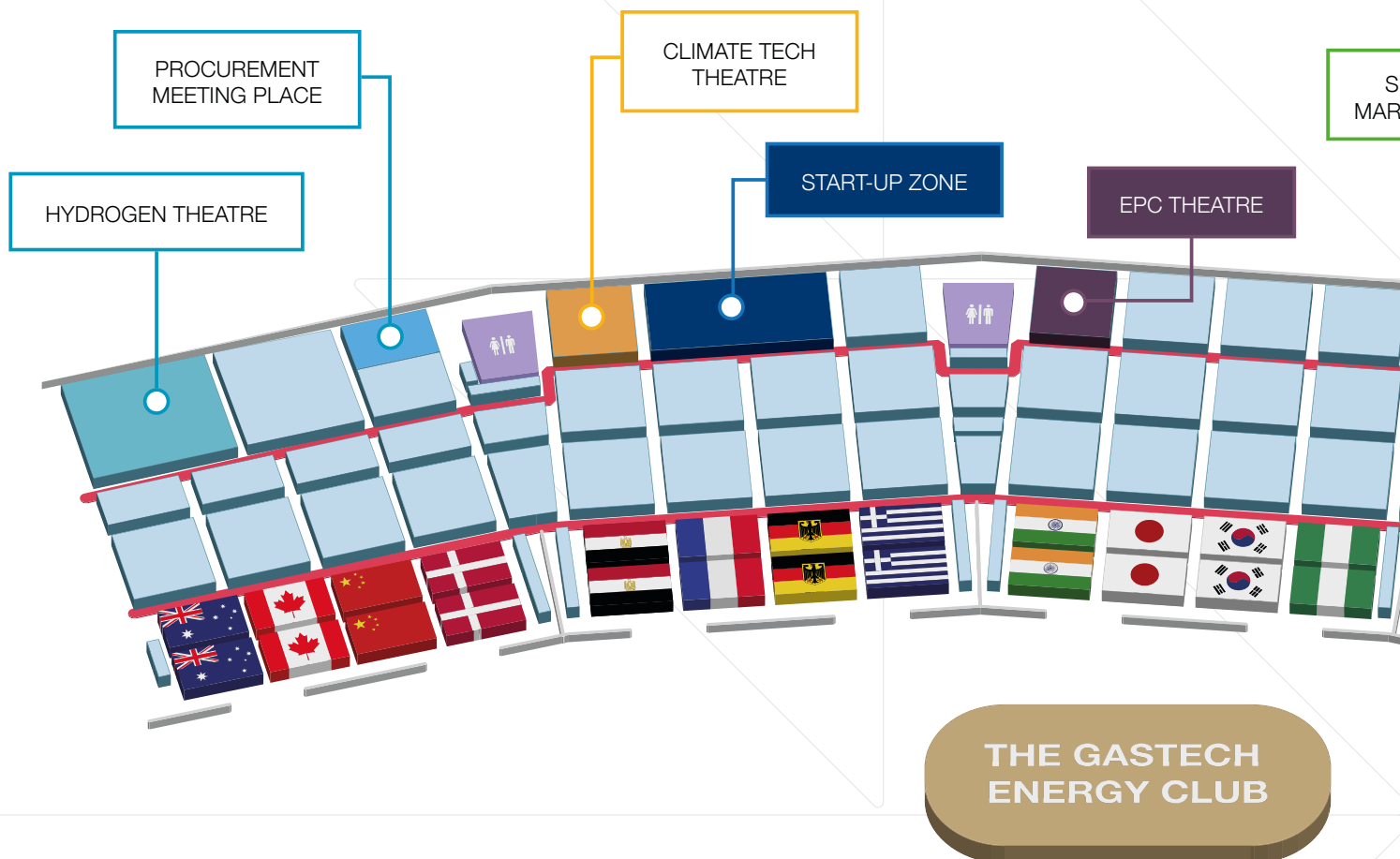
Who exhibits?

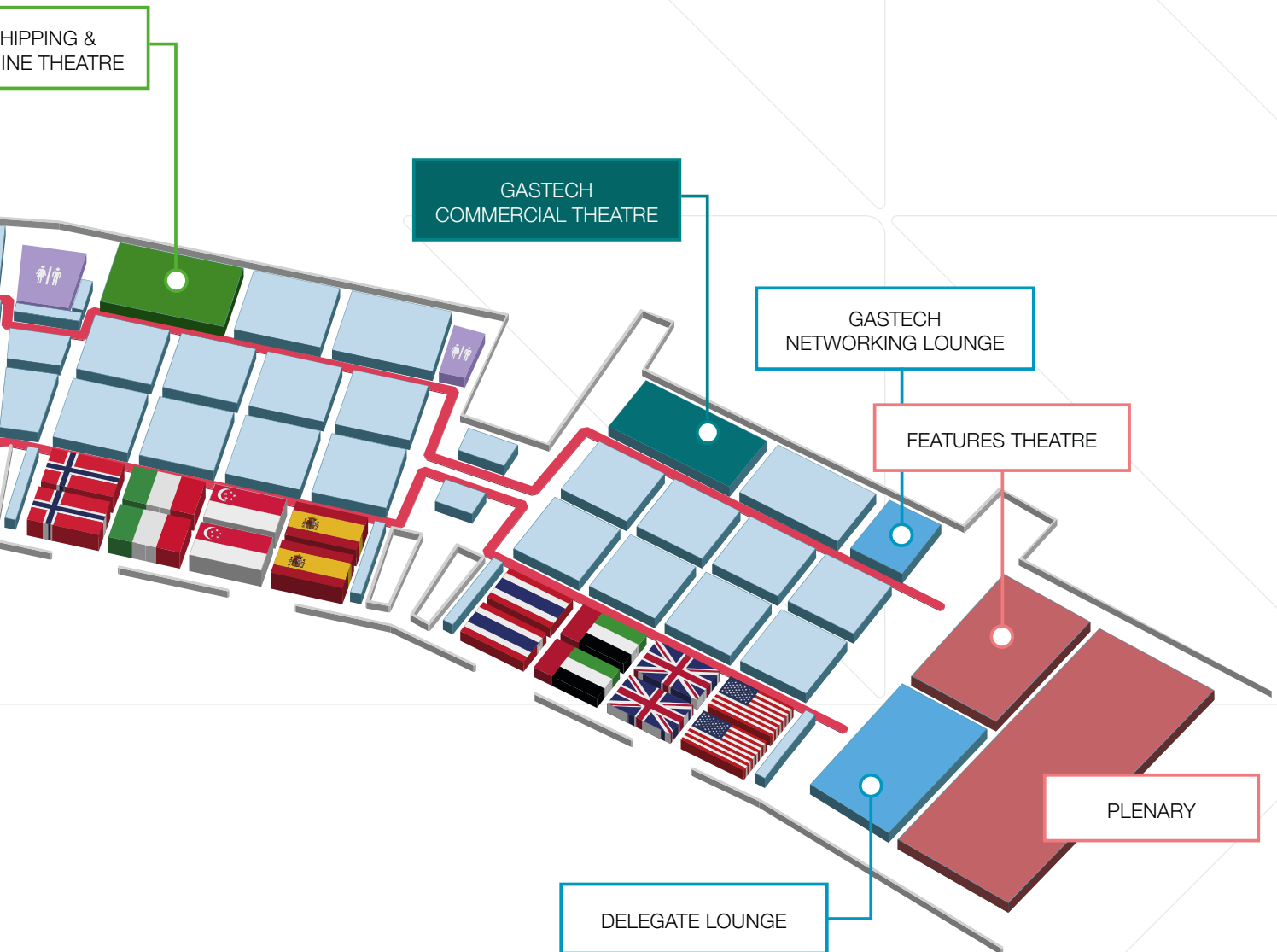
Gastech 2023 floorplan

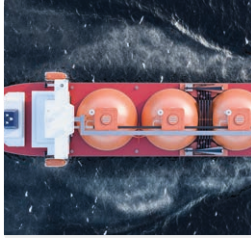


What's on the show floor

The Gastech exhibition provides the perfect setting for 750+ exhibitors from across the entire value chain to showcase their goods and services. The exhibition has a track record of generating billions in dollars of contracts and provides an exceptional opportunity for participants to explore the latest solutions, services, and technologies that will increase efficiencies, reduce carbon emissions, and enhance business performance.



Exhibition Zones



LNG infrastructure, shipping and marine zone

LNG infrastructure, shipping and marine resources have been stretched by recent high demand for new supply sources and mechanisms for delivery. This zone will showcase available infrastructure opportunities, alongside spotlighting how marine services, logistics and transportation of freight can be achieved in a greener, more sustainable and environmentally responsible way.



Climatetech

With the energy transition underway, the climate technologies zone will showcase a wide range of innovations and technologies and engineering applications. Exhibitors will be able to demonstrate solutions for carbon abatement and carbon capture as well as approaches towards measurement, verification and monitoring techniques. This area will also feature low-carbon solutions to help accelerate the speed of the transition.



Hydrogen and low-carbon solutions

Overcoming cost barriers will be critical to deploying hydrogen at scale, made more urgent by geo-political instability and the race towards a net-zero energy future. This zone plays host to Gastech's highly successful hydrogen exhibitors and this year expands to embrace other companies working to exploit low-carbon gases such as synthetic methane.



Low-carbon transport zone

To reach net-zero emissions targets by 2050, according to the IEA, transport emissions will need to fall 20% by 2030. The low-carbon transport zone is dedicated to showcasing technical efficiencies to reduce carbon intensity; solutions for low-carbon fuels and options to decarbonise aviation, shipping and heavy-duty road transport.



EPC and gas processing zone

As demand for LNG grows, EPC and Gas Processing provides a zone dedicated to the engineering procurement and construction industry as well as focusing on gas processing technologies and innovation.

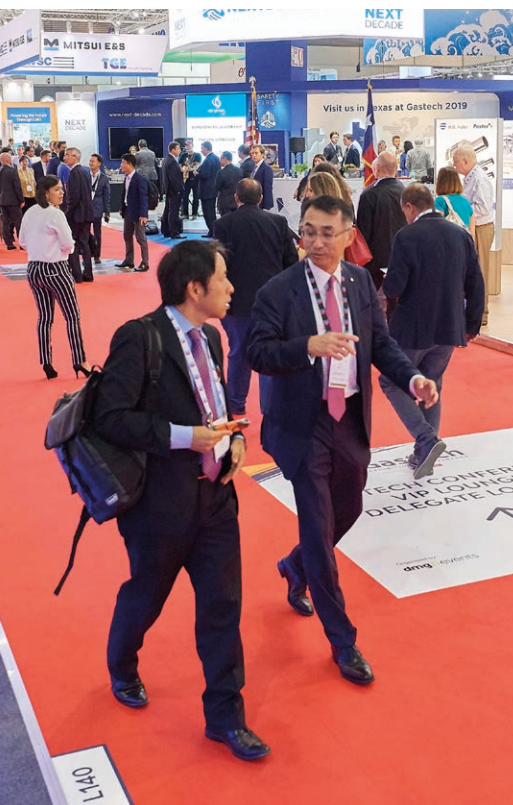

Start-up zone

According to the IEA, the transition to net-zero emissions requires a radical change in both the direction and scale of energy innovation. To deliver such accelerated innovation, a robust start-up ecosystem must be nurtured.

To scale these innovations sufficiently to address the challenges facing the energy system, corporate start-up partnerships are essential. Working in collaboration with such associations and trade agencies, Gastech 2023 will showcase some of the world's most promising energy entrepreneurs.

Gastech 2023 will provide a unique platform to showcase to the world's greatest gathering of energy technologists, the companies developing the next generation of transition solutions.

Procurement meeting place

The procurement meeting place will create a focal point for procurement within Gastech. This feature enables procurement experts to efficiently network with and discover new suppliers whilst also supporting the role smaller enterprises play within the natural gas, LNG, hydrogen, and low-carbon and climate technologies value chain.

Hosted buyer programme

The Gastech hosted buyer programme acts as a platform to efficiently connect buyers with relevant Gastech exhibitors. This provides a cost-effective and efficient way for procurement professionals to meet existing new suppliers.

A hosted buyer is classed as an individual responsible for purchasing the commodities, services, products, or solutions supplied by Gastech's exhibiting companies. Gastech 2023 in context

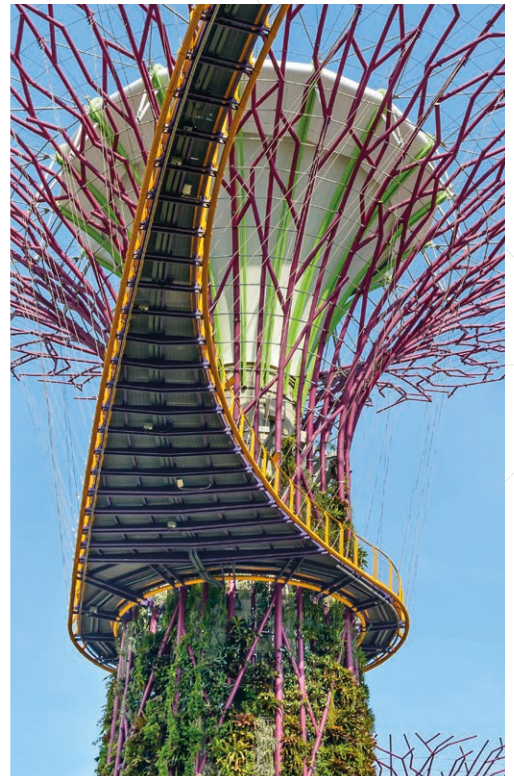
Setting the scene for the Gastech 2023 energy conversation

Gastech 2023 will host some of the most important conversations about the future of the industry. Discussions will link geopolitical events with impacts on the global economy and the likely consequences in both the near- and long-term for the role of natural gas, liquified natural gas (LNG), hydrogen, and low-carbon and climate technologies.

Singapore is playing a growing and important role in global energy markets. As a major energy-trading hub and the world's third largest refining centre, the city state will welcome over 300 ministers and CEOs as well over 4,000 policy makers and business leaders from over 100 countries.

The increase in Asian gas demand is well documented and is the result of economic, political and environmental factors. Gas, LNG, and now hydrogen, will be critical in ensuring energy security and acting as a bridging energy source to a low-carbon energy system in many Asian market.

With market instability spreading across the US and Europe and with inflationary pressures and slowing growth, many eyes will be on China, with analysts looking to see how slower growth, spiralling commodity prices and the ever present threat of a resurgence of COVID-19, will be managed. Nevertheless, Asian LNG demand, led by China is expected to remain high and potentially increase by as much as 25% through 2025. The Gastech 2023 conference will cover these topics as well a broad range of other issues pertinent to the industry.

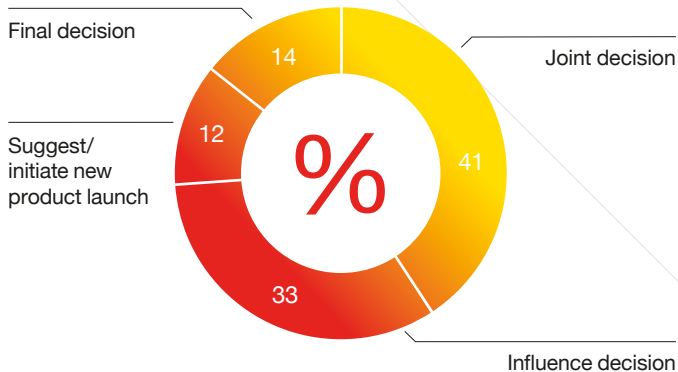

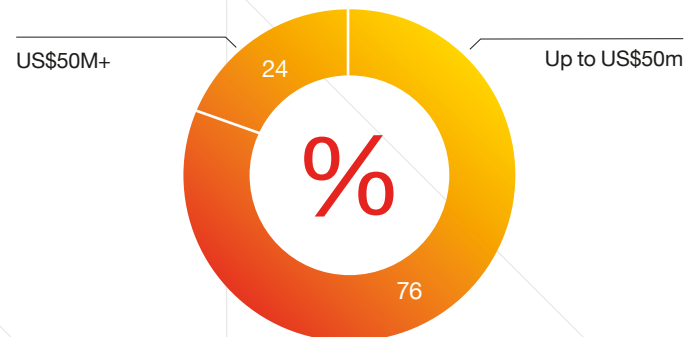
Who will you meet?



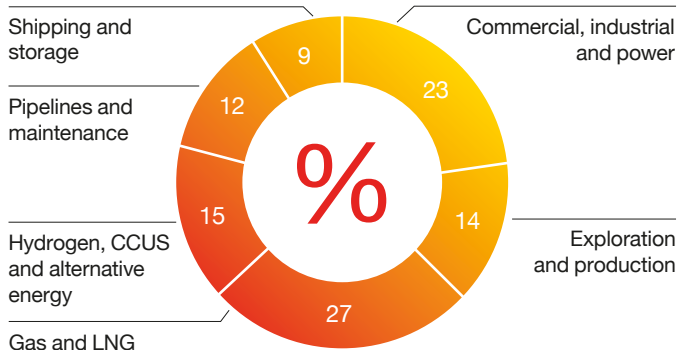
Attendee breakdown by level of purchasing responsibility



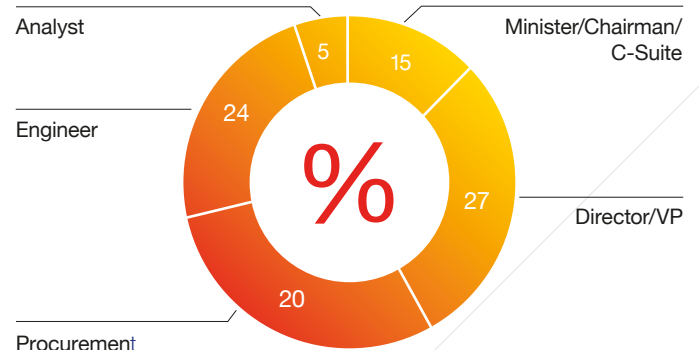
Attendee breakdown by yearly purchasing budget



Attendee by commercial focus

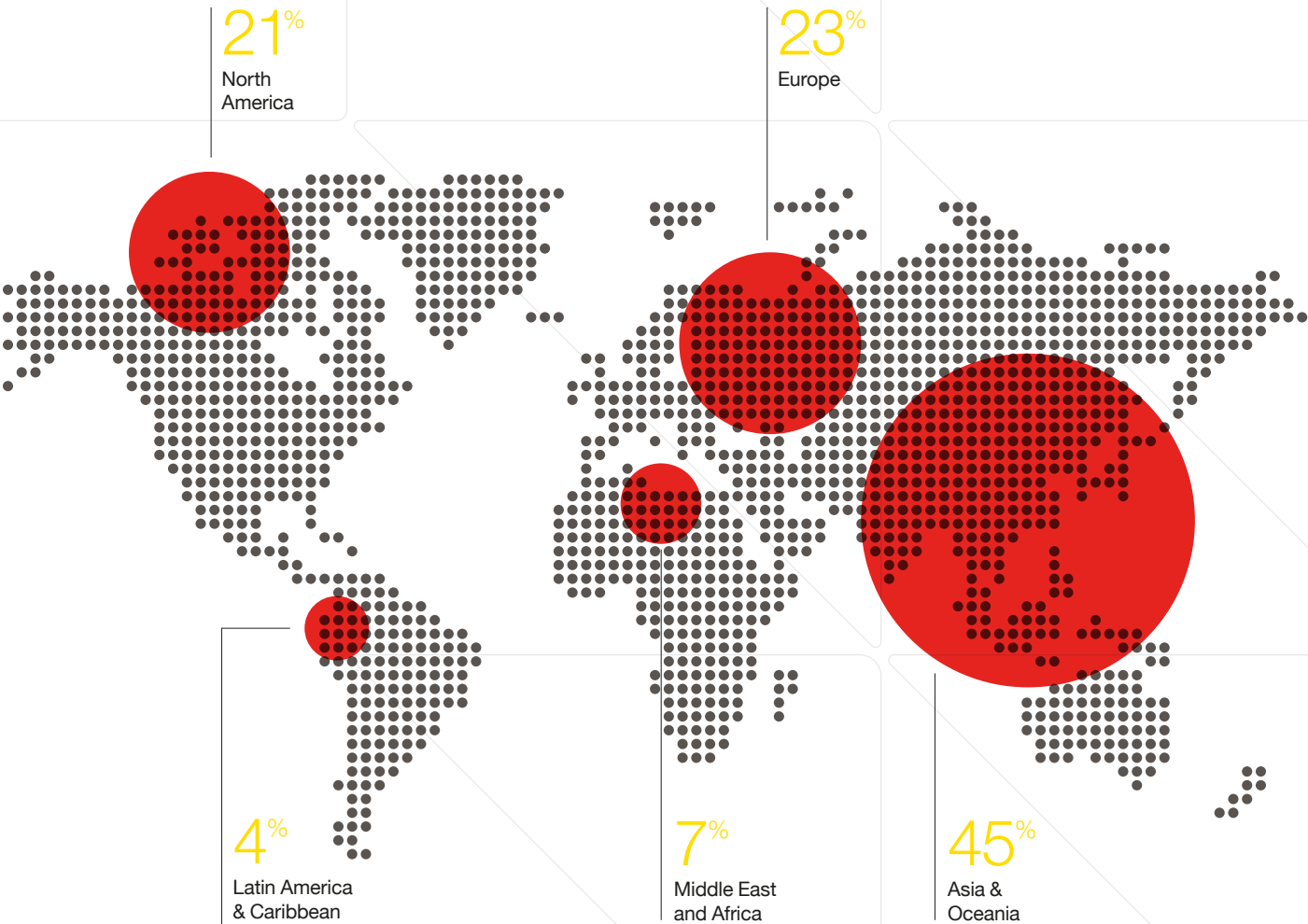


Attendee by professional profile

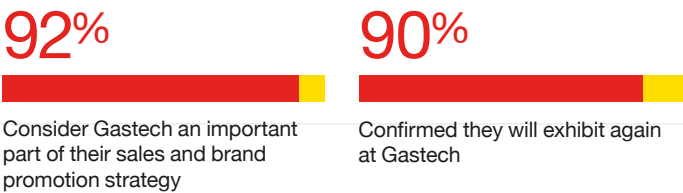


Attendee breakdown by region

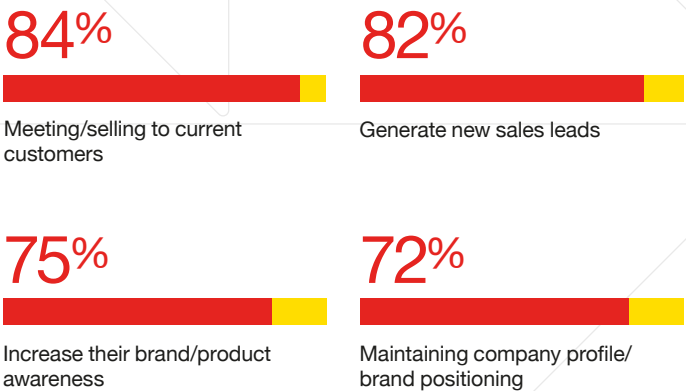
